What is a Melrose Park Neighbors Alert?

At our neighborhood meeting on October 10, 2005 Sergeant David Hirshbuhl of the Cheltenham Police Department's Community Police division announced a link with the Melrose Park Neighbors Association to start an email alert program.

If the police think there is an increase in activity in a particular section of our neighborhood, they will email me the information. I will then send it out to our email list with the hope that neighbors will notify the police if they see any mischievous behavior.
