Organic Lawn Care & the Alternative Groundcovers - The Outdoor "Flooring"
with Diana K. Weiner

Can you believe you can have a pseudo lawn in areas of your yard that are not used for recreation? A no mow, green and walk able surface is achievable in sun or shade. If you still need some green grass we will show you how to strengthen your lawn's root system and keep excess nutrients in the plants and out of our precious water table. Diana K. Weiner, Restoration Manager for Friends of High School Park, will teach you when to fertilize and what slow release organic fertilizers to use. If you've never had your soil tested to see if it needs fertilization, we will show you how to do a simple pH test and package a sample to send out for a complete analysis.
